## ChemClimCircle-2

The **ChemClimCircle-2** project helps public authorities in the **Baltic Sea Region** buy good and services that are climate-friendly, circular (reusable/recyclable), and free from harmful chemicals— something that is currently difficult to achieve in practice.

We are testing and improving a new method called the **ChemClimCircle approach** with about 50 real procurement cases across 15 cities, and then creating a practical "**Navigator**" tool that will help public buyers make purchases that address climate change, waste and chemical pollution all at once.

Thanks to this project, public authorities will be able to drive sustainable transformation more effectively by using their purchasing power to demand products that meet all three environmental goals instead of just one.
